



## STUDENT DRESS CODE

### A student uniform creates and promotes:

- A sense of pride in Altona Primary School.
- A sense of being a member of Altona Primary School.
- A feeling and appearance of unity.
- A ready means of identification during school excursions and sporting activities.
- The wearing of garments suitable for school activities.
- Minimise feelings of inequality in dress and to eliminate competitive dressing.

### IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGIES:

- All students are required to wear the prescribed school uniform of Altona Primary School as per school uniform policy endorsed by School Council.
- Wearing of school uniform will be expected and reinforced by all staff and regular uniform checks will be conducted.
- New parents will be supplied with a copy of the uniform requirements
- School uniform is available through the school Tuesday morning 8:45am – 9:30am and afternoon 3:15pm – 3:45pm.
- Second hand uniforms are available \$1 per item.
- The State Schools' Relief will be available in appropriate circumstances.

### The school uniform consists of:

#### SHIRTS

Long and short sleeve polo shirts (gold) with purple APS logo

#### TOPS

Purple windcheater with gold APS logo  
and purple jacket with gold APS logo  
Grey fleecy vest with gold APS logo  
Grade 6 rugby top

#### DRESS

School summer dress  
Grey tunic or skort  
Grey skirt

#### HAT

Wide brimmed gold slouch hat

#### SOCKS

White or school colours  
Grey or purple tights

#### SHOES

Appropriate footwear, closed in heel and toe

#### PANTS

Track pants purple or grey (straight leg or cuffed)  
Rugby shorts purple or grey  
Grey gaberdine shorts  
Gaberdine pants grey  
Grey bootleg pants

#### JEWELLERY

Studs/sleepers only, watches

#### SPORT/PHYS ED

Runners  
Track pants, gaberdine pants or school shorts

#### NOT PERMISSIBLE

Make up  
Jewellery – unless specified  
Open toe shoes  
Bootleg pants  
Leggings
