Go Girl, Go for IT is a free IT career showcase for all Victorian school girls from years 5 – 12, hosted every 2 years by the Victorian ICT for Women network. The aim of this event is to showcase the incredible range of vocational avenues available in IT to young girls.

The event provides opportunities for young girls to hear inspirational women talk about how they have built successful careers in IT, as well as to take part in competitions, interactive workshops and a tradeshow supported by a number of large corporate organisations.

Why Go Girl?

A career in IT is a fantastic opportunity for all, it is well paid, demand is high, you can work in any industry, from anywhere in the world and the opportunities associated are endless. We can't even name all of the roles yet, because they are forever developing.
