I would like to extend my gratitude to our community for making this term another successful one at APS.

COLOUR RUN FUNDRAISER

On Friday the 17th October, we will participate in a Colour Run as a whole school fundraising event. Information has been provided to all families about setting up a fundraising page and appears further in this newsletter. Eveyone is encouraged to participate by setting one up. Over the upcoming school holiday period, there is an incentive for all students who raise \$40 over the two week period, with all students who raise this amount receiving a Monty Plush.

UPCOMING GROUNDS WORKS

Over the upcoming school holiday period we will see some grounds works completed to enhance and improve our yard further.

Our current netball court, surrounding synthetic turf and hot shots courts are being replaced with a new synthetic turf surface. The current turf in this space is over 15 years old and is recently showing signs of wear and tear beyond repair. Approved by school council, this is being funded through strategic financial management of our school budget, enhanced by family contributions.

Our Friends and Families committee (FFC) are funding the replacement of the current netball goals with turnaround towers which will allow for basketball and netball to be played on the one court giving us further options. We will also see the installation of a second set of football goals at the Blyth St end of our oval, again funded by the FFC.

A second umbrella structure will also be installed in the area near the Upton/Railway St corner of our school, outside our senior classrooms, allowing for more shade and shelter. This is one of the final parts of the playground modernisation project.
